## Purpose of Award

The purpose of the Diakonia Award is to promote a culture of human rights and mobilise churches to be actively involved in social justice issues. ■

## Criteria

The Diakonia Award recognises outstanding contributions to the culture of human rights and is awarded to an individual who:

- ☼ Has made a significant contribution to advance and uphold human rights.
- ☼ Has actively worked and/or is working for social justice.
- ☼ Is a person of moral integrity.
- ☼ Has made a difference in other people's lives.

## Process

A call for nominations is circulated inviting submissions accompanied by a duly signed motivation letter of not more than two pages, to the Executive Director. The Executive Director then convenes a meeting of the selection committee. The committee then makes a recommendation to Council.

## Closing date for nominations

3 August 2012

The Award will be presented at the annual Diakonia Lecture on 24 August 2012
